Insertion Procedure

Step-1



- Set the flange to the uterine depth measured
- Gently advance the insertion tube through the cervical canal

Step-2



- Maintain the flange 1.5cm to 2cm from cervical os
- Allow sufficient space for arms

Step-3



- Release Emily
- Cut the threads perpendicular to the length, leaving 3cm length outside cervix
