1. Spare parts

Added para:

The supplier must enclose with their Techno-Commercial bid an undertaking to supply necessary spares for the next 10 years after issue of notification of award, as per the format given in Annexure-1 of this Amendment.

2. WARRANTY

Added para:

The Supplier along with its Indian Agent and the CMC Provider shall always accord most favoured client status to the Purchaser vis-a-vis its other Clients/ Purchasers of its equipment/ machines/ goods etc. of identical description and shall always give the most competitive price for its machines/ equipment supplied to the Purchaser/ Consignee.

For Sch. No. 23; Ultrasonic Cutting and Coagulation Device:

Hand piece with shears will not be covered under warranty. Price for hand piece with shears is to be quoted separately by the bidder and it will be valid during the warranty period. For price evaluation purpose, Price of hand piece with shears (as per BOQ mentioned in Technical specification) having a life of minimum 90 surgeries each will be taken in to account. Manufacturer has to give an undertaking for life of each hand piece in terms of no. of surgeries.

CLARIFICATION TO BIDDERS

In case of supply of the imported goods on CIP Named port of Destination Basis, the additional extended Insurance (local transportation and storage) would be borne by the Supplier/ Indian Subsidiary/ local company/ agency from the port of entry to the consignee site for a period including 3 months beyond date of delivery for an amount equal to 110% of the overall expenditure to be incurred by the purchaser from ware house to ware house (consignee site) on all risk basis.

In case the bidder quotes partly indigenous items and partly imported items, the following clause for Delivery period shall be incorporated in the NoA:

For Indigenous Goods:
