The price bid of the bidders who are disqualified at the technical scrutiny and on-site evaluation will be returned un-opened. The short listed bidders will be informed about the time, date and venue of the price bid opening.
- 24.2 For opening of Financial Bid, only those Bidders qualifying in the Technical bid will be considered.
