Tender for supply of pharmaceutical products to HLL/HLL's retail outlets/ HLL CFA's across India under rate contract for one year.

It has been decided to invite tender for supply of pharmaceutical products to HLL/ HLL's retail outlets /HLL CFA's from manufacturers / authorised distributors/ suppliers for the supply of pharmaceutical products to HLL and to Outlets of HLL inside the Government Hospitals /AIIMS across India.

I. Background

HLL Lifecare Limited (HLL) is a Government of India enterprise under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare. HLL, a world leader in contraceptives, has grown into a comprehensive healthcare company. A parallel world of service exists under HLL Lifecare apart from its products. Healthcare Services Division & Retail Business Division offers outsourcing partnerships to partnering institutions in the areas of diagnostic services, pharmacy and other specialist services.

II. Scope of Tender

HLL is setting up retail drugs outlets and diagnostic services in various Govt. Hospitals across India as a joint initiative. The outlets will provide quality pharmaceutical, surgical, implants, instruments, medicines, lenses, frames and surgical consumables etc in the hospitals at an economical rate. The outlet will mainly cater requirements of all departments of hospital including super specialty.

Recent initiative launched by HLL, AMRIT (Affordable Medicines and Reliable Implants for Treatment) offers medicines for cancer and cardio vascular diseases at discounted rates at AIIMS and AIIMS like hospitals throughout India.

The major details of present tender are the following:

1. Scope includes the supply of Pharmaceutical products to HLL/HLL retail drug stores/ C&FAs at various parts of the country as per the purchase orders issued by HLL during the tenure of contract
2. Tentative quantity per order for generic products will be minimum batch size of the manufacturer for each product or as per our requirement. For Generic branded products and Branded products the quantity shall be as per our requirement.
3. Suppliers must ensure strict compliance to all statutory regulations and quality standards.
4. Primary manufacturers/authorized agents/Distributors are allowed to participate in the Tender. Manufacturer's authorization form in original may be submitted by participating authorized agents.

V. Minimum Eligibility Criteria

1. The average annual turnover of the tenderer in the last three years shall not be less than Rs.2 crores and a certificate to this effect duly certified by a chartered accountant is to be submitted along with the tender.
2. The tenderer should have a market standing for the last one year or more. Documentary proof for the same in the form of supply orders from any Central/State Government Departments or Central/State PSU's or local bodies or reputed Private Institutions is to be submitted along with the tender.

8. Annexure-4-Under taking letter for replacement of complaint/defective goods
9. Distributor/Importer shall submit the declaration attached in Annex 1.
10. Authorization letter from manufacturer ((Self–attested Copy).
11. Documentary proof for establishing market standing for last one year or more years in the form of supply orders from any Central/State Government Departments or Central/State PSU's or local bodies or reputed Private Institutions. (from the manufacturer in case of Distributor)
12. Documentary proof for establishing the average annual turnover of the tenderer in the last three years is not be less than Rs.2 crores certified by a chartered accountant.

VII. Major terms and Conditions

a) Period of Validity of Bid

Bid shall remain valid up to 12 months from the date of opening the financial bid. However, HLL reserves the right to extend the Price validity by another 12 months or for further period based on mutual agreement.

b) Prices

The products as per Annexure 5 are based on the Molecules/composition required by HLL. Manufacturers/Distributors are to submit separate price bids as per Annexure-2 for their equivalent branded product, Branded Generic and Generic. In the case of Branded or Branded Generic products being quoted the brand name may be specified additionally in the price bid as per Annexure 2.

c) Fixed prices:

The prices quoted by the bidder shall remain firm and fixed during the currency of the contract which would be twelve months (can be extendable) from the date of opening of the price bid and not subject to any variations on any account during this period. Revision in rates due to DPCO is acceptable based on mutual consent.

d) Parallel rate contracts:

HLL reserves the right to enter into the rate contract / parallel rate contracts with one or more parties or to place adhoc contracts simultaneously or at any time during the currency of contract, with one or more suppliers.

e) Inspection:

The supplier should submit the batch test reports for the supplies made to the HLL. The purchaser reserves the right to sample check the consignment at the time of delivery for which cost shall be borne by the supplier (pre-dispatch inspection)

f) Shelf Life:

The supplies of medicines / drugs should be from fresh stock only. At the time of receipt of medicines, they should have the latest manufacturing date with a minimum 2/3rd of the life of the drug. Drugs/medicines to be supplied should be of standard quality/quantity as per IP/BP/USP/NFI or equivalent specification and must be as per the formulations/standard approved/specified by the Drug Control Act and Food & Drug Control Administration Regulation or as per the regulation of any such statutory authorities.

g) Indemnity:

The supplier hereby indemnifies HLL Lifecare Ltd and will always keep it indemnified against all terms, claims, demands, losses, costs, expenses etc. arising out of supply of drugs or in respect of this contract.

h) Short supply:

If any shortages in sealed boxes are detected then supplier should be held responsible. In such a case, the supplier will have to make good of the loss or refund the payment for such quantity equal to its F.O.R. value if the payment is already made. If the payment is not made, purchaser will have right to deduct the payment for the equivalent F.O.R. value corresponding to quantity found short.

i) Flexibility of prices:

The purchaser has option to re-negotiate with rate contract holder to bring down the rate contract prices whenever market fluctuations affect the prices abnormally.

j) **Goods replacement:**

Supplier must replace the non-moving/near expiry goods at HLL Stores, with fresh batch upon demand by HLL.

VIII. Bid Opening and Evaluation

- k) Bids received before the dead line of the submission of the bid will be opened on the date and time of opening mentioned above. Bidders wishing to be present at the time of such opening may send their duly authorized representative. HLL will scrutinize the bid for compliance to the specifications and documentation requirement as per the bid document. HLL will determine the substantial responsiveness of each bid to the terms and conditions of the bidding documents. If a bid is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by HLL and may not subsequently be made responsive by the bidder by correction of the non-conformity. HLL reserves the right to accept or reject any bid or to annul the bidding process and reject all bids at any time prior to Contract award, without assigning any reason thereof. The manufacturers/Distributors who meet the eligibility criteria and has offered the lowest price for Generic would be considered for the supply of the material. For Branded and Branded Generic the manufacturers/Distributors who meet the eligibility criteria would be empaneled and based on the requirements the rates shall be negotiated and finalized.

IX. Settlement of Disputes

Arbitration shall not be a means of settlement of any dispute or claim arising out of the contract relating to the work. Any disputes or difference arising between the parties with respect to the performance of any part of this agreement or anything connected therewith, etc shall as far as possible be mutually settled by the process of dialog and negotiation. Any disputes or differences or questions or claims arising under or relating to a concerning or touching this agreement shall be referred for arbitration in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.

The arbitration proceedings shall be held at Thiruvananthapuram. The award passed by the arbitrator shall be final and binding on the parties hereto. The conduct of such arbitration shall be in English

X. Major Responsibilities of Supplier

- a. The suppliers have to supply the goods as per the delivery schedules and quantity mentioned in the Purchase Order. Supplies made shall be in strict conformance with the stipulations of rate contract and the respective purchase orders.
- b. The successful bidder shall acquire in its name all permits, approvals, and/or licenses from all local, state, or national government authorities or public service undertakings that are necessary for the performance of the Contract.
- c. The Supplier shall comply with all laws in force in India. The laws will include all national, provincial, municipal, or other laws that affect the performance of the Contract and are binding upon the bidder. The Bidders shall indemnify and hold harmless HLL from and against any and all liabilities, damages, claims, fines, penalties, and expenses of whatever nature arising or resulting from the violation of such laws by the bidder or its personnel except that caused by HLL.
- d. Any product related legal issues shall be handled and connected expenses therewith shall be borne by the bidder/ manufacturer only.

XI. Termination

HLL may at any time terminate the Contract for any reason by giving the Bidders a thirty days (30) notice of termination
