1	MATERIAL FOR PSYCHOMETRY
1.1	WPS ELECTRONIC TAPPING TEST
	Should be an accurate, easy-to-use finger or foot tapping measure for neuropsychological evaluation
	Compact electronic tapper should automatically start a 10-second timer as soon as the first tap is made. The digital display should show a dash (--) until 10 seconds are up--at which point it shows the number of taps made during that interval. Additional taps, made after the 10-second period should be elapsed and should not be recorded.
	Should operate with 9 V battery
	Should be supplied with plastic casing
1.2	MODIFIED WISCONSIN CARD SORTING TEST
	The M-WCST should be a modification of the original Wisconsin Card Sorting Test that eliminates all cards from the original 128-card deck that share more than one attribute with a stimulus card (e.g., each response card whose stimuli match a stimulus card in both color and form was eliminated). This results in a 48-card deck, which is used along with four stimulus cards.
	This modifications should enable impaired and elderly adults to more easily understand the directions, reducing frustration.
	Four scores are calculated for the M-WCST: Number of Categories Correct, Number of Perseverative Errors, Number of Total Errors, and Percent of Perseverative Errors. In addition, an Executive Function Composite score can be calculated.
1.3	STROOP COLOUR AND WORD TEST (ADULTS)
	The Stroop is based on the observation that individuals can read words much faster than they can identify and name colors. The cognitive dimension tapped by the Stroop is associated with cognitive flexibility, resistance to interference from outside stimuli, creativity, and psychopathology--all of which influence the individual's ability to cope with cognitive stress and process complex input.
	The test should feature a three-page test booklet. On the first page, the words "RED," "GREEN," and "BLUE," are printed in black ink and repeated randomly in columns. On the second page, the item "XXXX" appears repeatedly in columns, printed in red, green, or blue ink. On the third page (referred to as the interference page), the words "RED," "GREEN," and "BLUE" are printed in red, green, or blue ink--but in no case do the words and the colors in which they are printed match.

	For example, the word "BLUE" appears in either red or green ink. The subject's task is to look at each page and move down the columns, reading words or naming the ink colors as quickly as possible, within a given time limit
	The test yields three scores, based on the number of items completed on each of the three stimulus sheets. In addition, you can calculate an interference score, which is useful in determining the individual's cognitive flexibility, creativity, and reaction to cognitive stress
