TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Tenderers should be experienced and licensed in both the treatments
- 2. The Party should provide the detailed description of the material, trade name/Chemical name, method of application of the material and concentration of the material dosage quantity during application.
- 3. The party should furnish the material safety data sheet (MSDS) of the material which includes
 - a) Safety precautions during handling.
 - b) Antidote treatment which included the first aid measures, drug therapy, applicable warranty, caution steps.
 - c) Method of handling the materials and its effect on inhalation, skin and oral toxicity.
 - d) Details of Storage conditions and package conditions applicable.
- 4. Reports on Laboratory field trial details including past technical literature has to be submitted by the party.
- 5. The party may also furnish details on environmental friendly measures suggested after application.
- 6. The party should furnish environmental clearance certificate (ECC) of each of the materials used to demonstrate that the materials are not hazardous to Environment.
- 7. The tenderer should have GST Registration.
- 8. The Pesticides having ISI mark only will be used for the treatment.
- 9. The contractor will be fully responsible for the supervision and control of the treatments.
- 10. The prescribed Tender forms can be obtained from the Purchase section from 10AM to 5.00PM on all working days from **21.01.2021**. Last date of receipt of quotations will will be 3.00 p.m on 13.02.2021. The quotations received after the due date will not be accepted or considered under any circumstances.

- 11. The received quotations will be opened at 3.30PM on 13.02.2021.
- 12. The contractor should take necessary Insurance to take care of any eventuality for the persons engaged by them for doing the treatment work.
- 13. The contractor at own cost will bring all materials required for the treatments.
- 14. EMD: Not applicable. Bidder has to submit Bid security declaration as per Schedule H.
- 15. The Statutory payments such as ESI, PF Income Tax, KVAT etc. as applicable, are to be paid by the contractor.
- 16. The present area for disinfestations is nearly 5300 Sq. ft. This may vary depending on the requirements from time to time. Hence rate per Sq. ft. should be quoted.
- 17. On awarding the contract, an agreement has to be executed in stamp paper worth of Rs.200/-.(Rupees Two hundred only). The agreement draft is available in HR section for reference.
- 18. Incomplete quotation will be rejected summarily.
- 19. The successful Bidder shall deposit 3% of the Work order value towards Security deposit.
